## Methods Used to Determine Which Students Receive Aid and How Much

All enrolled students are eligible to apply for assistance. Students are able to apply using the College's Emergency Aid Request Form, available in the Dean of Students' Office. Once an application is received, the Emergency Aid Review Committee reviews each request individually and will be in touch with students. Students are able to indicate on the application form how they would like the funds disbursed, either applied to their student account to support their tuition charges or sent directly to them.

## Instructions or Directions Given to Students

Students awarded funding were sent an e-mail notifying them of their award and a confirmation of how the funds will be disbursed to them, as indicated on their original application. The options were to have the funding sent directly to the student, have the funding applied to their student account, or have the funding split between these two options.

If a student reached out with financial concerns, they were directed to complete the request for emergency funding through the Dean of Students Office. If awarded, they received the same e-mail notification as above.
